Sealed proposals for **Media Services**, will be received by the Purchasing Agent, Jefferson County Department of Health, General Service Annex, 401 14th Street South, Birmingham, AL 35233, until 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders wishing to bid can download the complete solicitation including the specifications and bid forms via the internet at www.jcdh.org (go to the ABOUT header and click on BIDS), or by visiting the Purchasing Office at the address shown above, or by calling (205) 930-1961, fax (205) 930-1060 and requesting a copy be mailed to you. Any addenda will be available on the internet. Bidder is responsible for checking for addenda until bid opening date. Addenda will be mailed only to those vendors who were provided a copy in person or by mail. Proposers are strongly encouraged to read the entire solicitation.

All proposals must be submitted on Bid Form in a sealed envelope indicating "SEALED BID – RFP# 24-02-02, Media Services" with opening date and bid number printed on outside of envelope.

All bidders must complete and return the notarized State of Alabama disclosure form included in the bid package <u>and</u> the Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract; and must provide a copy of their E-verify certificate with the assigned number from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, W-9 Form, and Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act Supplemental Form and all other documents listed in the enclosure.

It is <u>required</u> for any contract/purchase exceeding \$10,000.00 that the bidder submits with their bid either certified check, a cashier's check or a bid bond payable to the Jefferson County Department of Health in the amount of \$500.00. In order for any bid award to be considered that exceeds \$10,000, it must be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond or check. Bid bonds will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of the award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond or check shall be forfeited.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening. Jefferson County Department of Health is exempt from all tax. This statement in no way is to be construed as relieving a seller or contractor from paying any tax assessed to him as a seller or contractor.

Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH) expressly reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or parts of proposals and to make the award all or none or per line item on the merit and/or feature of method and quality, delivery, and service availability as the best interest of the Jefferson County Department of Health appears.

Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to require documentation that each bidder is an established business and is abiding by the ordinances, regulations, and laws of their community and the State of Alabama. If you are required by any regulatory agency to maintain a professional license or

certification to provide any product and/or service solicited under this Request for Proposal (RFP), the JCDH reserves the right to require documentation of current license and/or certification before considering and awarding the bid.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Jefferson County Department of Health is currently soliciting sealed RFPs for a Marketing/Public Relation Consultant to develop strategy and messaging communication for (i) targeted outreach, increase the general community awareness of JCDH Title X Family Planning services and locations, medical mobile unit, and access for males and teens, (ii) digital messaging and purchase of digital media, (iii) serve as a liaison with news media and others to help build relationships and raise awareness of JCDH's brand and services. The successful bidder will be notified of RFP award via the Jefferson County Department of Health's Notice of Award letter and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract.

Funding will be allocated under the grant to initiate a digital education campaign to increase community awareness of available services, location of clinic sites, and to conduct targeted outreach and education among high need populations. A marketing firm will be contracted to develop and produce educational, informational, and culturally appropriate content designed for the target audience.

This project is supported by the Office of the Population Affairs (OPA) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services as part of a financial assistance award totaling \$1,619,891.00 with \$1,499,315.00 (92%) funded by OPA/OASH/HHS and \$120,576.00 (8%) funded by the Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH). ABOUT JCDH

The Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH) located in Birmingham, Alabama serves a population of about 660,000 residents. JCDH serves the most populous county in the state through providing primary and limited specialty care and core public health services to county residents. The mission of the Department is to prevent disease, assure access to quality health care, promote a healthy lifestyle and environment, and protect against public health threats.

AWARD

Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH) will develop an evaluation team to evaluate this RFP by a scoring methodology. The evaluation criteria listed in the proposal shall include; but not limited to, the scope of work defined in the RFP. JCDH shall evaluate and make the award on the proposal that is determined to be in the best interest of Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH).

CONTRACT TERMS

The bid will be valid for a period of a **one (1) year term**. Successful bidder will be notified of ITB award via JCDH's Notice of Award letter and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract. <u>Please</u> **note that this project requires completion of the work by March 31, 2024, due to grant requirements.**

TERMINATION

The bid may be terminated by JCDH with a thirty (30) day written notice of cancelation to the other party regardless of reason. Any violation of this agreement shall constitute a breach and default of this agreement. Such termination shall not relieve the contractor of any liability to JCDH for damages sustained by virtue of a breach by the contractor.

PRICE

Price will remain firm for the entire duration of the bid period. Price is to include <u>all</u> related fees. Invoice(s) must be itemized and billed after delivery/completion.

FREIGHT

Price includes transportation, fuel, handling, service, freight charges and deliveries as specified and JCDH will pay no additional fees.

TAX

Jefferson County Department of Health is exempt from all tax. However, bidder shall be responsible for any tax that may be levied or assessed by reason of this transaction.

PRF-PAY

No pre-payments will be made prior.

ADDITIONS TO CONTRACT

The County has attempted to list all components related to RFP for "Media Services" solution that will be required during the term of the contract. However, JCDH reserves the right to purchase additional services as needed from the successful bidder as it relates to this scope of work for this said project.

PROPOSAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

The scoring methodology will consist of factors weighted in accordance with its importance to JCDH. However, the following factors will include but not limited to these items when making a final recommendation.

INTERPRETATIONS

No modification, deviation, substitution, or other such changes will be made without Owner's prior written approval. The Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to reject any or all proposals submitted and to make the award in the best interest of the Health Department.

INSURANCE

Bidder shall furnish to the Board upon execution of this Agreement, a certificate of insurance as evidence of adequate professional and public liability insurance insuring vendor, the Board and Board's agents, servants, and employees as additional insured.

RFP proposals will be rejected if there is reason to believe that collusion exists among the bidders. No participants in such collusion will be considered in future proposals for the same work.

Bidder must have all necessary business licenses as required by the State of Alabama and Jefferson County. All items must conform strictly to the specifications and shall be subjected to evaluation upon acceptance. In the event that any item is deemed unacceptable or not in conformity with the specifications, items will be rejected, and items of proper quality as set forth in these specifications shall be furnished in place thereof at the expense of the successful bidder.

Use of specific names and numbers is not intended to restrict the bidding of any seller and/or manufacturer but is solely for the purpose of indicating the type, size and quality, material, service, or equipment considered best adapted to the JCDH's intended use.

Bidder will furnish a minimum of three (3) references. References will be accepted only from companies that provide similar type of scope of work as requested herein.

No bidder shall be allowed to offer more than one proposal for the said project. If said bidder should submit more than one proposal for the said project described therein those proposals shall be rejected.

INCURRING COSTS

The Jefferson County Department of Health will not be liable for any costs incurred in preparing bid responses.

TABLE OF CONTENTS

A table of contents should be provided and allow for easy access to all proposal components.

NUMBER OF PROPOSALS

One (1) signed original AND two (2) copies submitted with proposal package. Proposals shall be prepared in accordance with the Proposal Format in the "How to Apply" section. Proposals not complying with this format may be considered non-responsive and may be removed from consideration on this basis.

PROPOSALS

Proposals should be structured in such a way to address the ability to answer all objectives of the Media Services.

APPLICABLE LAW

A contract entered into as a result of this proposal shall be governed and interpreted under the laws of the State of Alabama. The contract shall be on a standard JCDH form as modified for this particular transaction. As JCDH is a public agency, its standard contract contains provisions required by Alabama law and regulations. Those provisions include, but are not limited to, the following topics.

Alabama Law (Section 41-4-142, Code of Alabama 1975) provides that every bid submitted and contract executed shall contain a certification that the vendor, contractor, and all of its affiliates that make sales for delivery into Alabama, or leases for use in Alabama, are registered, collecting, and remitting Alabama state and local sales, use, and/or lease tax on all taxable sales and leases into Alabama. BY SUBMITTING THIS PROPOSAL, THE FIRM IS HEREBY CERTIFYING THAT THEY ARE IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH ALABAMA LAW, THEY ARE NOT BARRED FROM SUBMITTING PROPOSALS OR ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT PURSUANT TO 41-4-142, AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE AWARDING AUTHORITY MAY DECLARE THE CONTRACT VOID IF THE CERTIFICATION IS FALSE.

Alabama Law (Section 31-13-9(k), Code of Alabama 1975) provides the following language must be included in every public contract bid in Alabama: "By signing the Agreement and this Addendum, the Board and the Contractor affirm, for the duration of this Agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue

to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, any Contracting Party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of this Agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom." SCOPE OF WORK/REQUIREMENTS

The Jefferson County Department of Health is currently soliciting sealed RFPs for a Marketing/Public Relation Consultant to develop strategy and messaging communication for (i) targeted outreach, increase the general community awareness of JCDH Title X Family Planning services and locations, medical mobile unit, and access for males and teens, (ii) digital messaging and purchase of digital media to help build relationships and raise awareness of JCDH's brand and services. The bidder's scope of work shall include but not be limited to the following tasks:

- 1. The successful bidder must provide creative campaign development and execution.
- 2. The successful bidder must provide/coordinate media strategies.
- 3. The successful bidder must provide a modular platform by which media campaigns can be changed out with relative ease in a relatively short period of time (days not weeks).
- 4. The successful bidder must provide regular and frequent (no less frequently than monthly) metrics reports on the number of impressions made by said campaigns.
- 5. The successful bidder must have a comprehensive marketing campaign to include, but not limited to, radio, TV, digital and signs.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. The successful firm will work closely with JCDH project team to receive information about Family Planning services and the vision for the creative materials.
- 2. The successful firm will produce first draft of creative materials for JCDH staff review by March 15, 2024.
- 3. The success full firm receive feedback and produce the final version of creative materials by March 29, 2024.
